A Winterwatch will be very pleased with the piles of donated food and toiletries beautifully displayed by the Parents' Association committee members along our corridors.

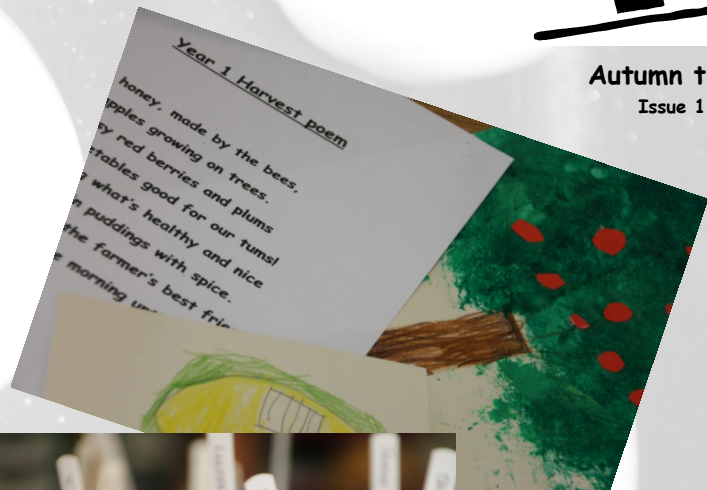
R We are looking forward to seeing the daffodils blooming in the Marie Curie Little Pots of Care in the new year when we will revisit the science topic of growth and change.
