- 1 Entry is available to current and past, pupils, parents and staff (teaching, support & Central Services). Only one piece may be submitted per artist. No group work is allowed.
- 2 All work should have been created by the artist in the past two years and must be an original piece.
- 3 We will endeavour to exhibit all work. However, we reserve the right to make final decisions on its suitability in a school setting.
- 4 Artists over the age of 18 (unless current Bolton School pupils or staff) must include payment of £5 on submission of artwork for exhibition. Please note: as a Not for Profit Charity we do not offer any refunds for registrations or submissions due to the cost of running the competition.
- 5 Completed entry form and payment (if applicable) should be sent to the Open Art Exhibition Team, Bolton School by Friday 21st September 2018. Entry forms may be emailed or posted (see entry form for details) and payment made by cheque payable to 'Bolton School' or BACS to:

- 6 Relevant artwork should be framed and mirror-plated.
- 7 All artwork must be delivered to Bolton School between 8am and 4pm on Thursday 8th November and Friday 9th November 2018.
- 8 Artists must attach a copy of their completed entry form to the back of their work on submission.
- 9 All work must remain on exhibition for the full duration of Exhibition Week and may not be removed before 9am on Friday 16th November.
- 10 All artwork must be collected after the exhibition from Bolton School between 1pm & 4pm on Friday 16th November or between 9am and 4pm on Monday 19th November 2018.
- 11 Upon registering and entering this competition artists agree that Bolton School may reproduce their work (at no fee and not for resale) only in association with the competition & exhibitions (including press/publicity/website & catalogue and any other printed material, flyers, postcards and posters advertising the Bolton School Open Art exhibition and future related events).
- 12 The School has no liability for the loss of or damage to artwork whilst at School. By signing the registration form, the entrant accepts that any the organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage to the artwork, however caused, either in transit to and from the exhibition, during the exhibition, or during any period of storage, packing or unpacking, or in any period in which the work is in their keeping.
