

A brief summary of the National Mathematics and Physics SCITT Part-Time Course

Course length two academic years, three days per week.

Finance

Fees (QTS and PGCE): £ 6,935 per annum (Total fee for the two year course £13,870)

Bursary arrangements: Trainees are entitled to the full value of the bursary, spread over the two years. (i.e. if the bursary is £20,000, they would receive £10,000 per year for two years)

Year One

Compulsory attendance at the three day induction programme at the end of August.

Two days a week in a placement school

One day per week, trainees will attend the full day Hub training sessions

Year Two

Two days a week in a placement school

PGCE course, with optional attendance at weekly Hub training sessions with compulsory attendance once a term.

Attendance at celebration event at the end of year two (late June)

Notes:

1. This route is being offered to try to tap into a previously untapped pool!
2. The route will only be offered to **very** strong candidates.
3. It is anticipated that each student's programme will be created bespoke for them.
4. The 'two days' per week in a placement school could be spread e.g. over 4 days, following discussion and agreement with the trainee and placement school.
