

Sixth Form Scholarship, September 2021 Entry (External candidates)

Scholarships may be awarded to any girl not in receipt of a Bursary who shows excellent academic achievement and leadership and who has also excelled in one or more areas outside the academic arena, for example in Music, Drama, Outdoor Pursuits, or Sport. Scholarships may be awarded to pupils currently at Bolton School or to those joining for the Sixth Form only.

Sixth Form Scholarships will be awarded as a fixed amount of, for example, £1000, £500, or £250 per year. The total amount of Scholarships awarded in a particular year in the Girls' Division will not exceed £11,000. The Scholarship will normally be held for two years, Year 12 and Year 13, unless it is removed because a student does not maintain her excellent standard of work and extra curricular participation during the Sixth Form or because her personal conduct is a cause of concern. Scholars will be expected to participate fully in the academic life of the School, including by attending Enrichment activities during the school day and in the evening. Staff will be given the name of those girls who are Scholars and mention will be made of the Scholarship in School publications and in references, for example on UCAS forms.

Please complete the form neatly in black ink or type your answers. The information which you provide will be reviewed by senior staff alongside your most recent school reports and you may be invited to an interview shortly afterwards.

- You may be awarded a Scholarship for the Sixth Form, subject to certain grades being achieved at GCSE;
- You will not be awarded a Scholarship for the Sixth Form.
